The CMC [Centre for Material Culture] is an over-ground bunker located at the junction of Gilpin Road and Kingfisher Way.

By bus: There are two lines near the CMC, the U and the PR3 Park & Ride

- The U (Universal) Bus

-- > Exit at the Bowling Club, which is a 7-minute walk to the CMC. Walk along Brooklands Avenue and turn into Aberdeen Avenue. At the end of Aberdeen Avenue, turn right and walk along Gilpin Road.

- The PR3 Park & Ride

-- > Exit at Nuffield Hospital, which is a 10-minute walk to the CMC. From Trumpington Road, turn left onto Brooklands Avenue, and turn left onto Aberdeen Avenue. At the end of Aberdeen Avenue, turn right and walk along Gilpin Road.
